What community solar options does Avista offer?

Avista offers Community Solar and Solar Select as part of its commitment to renewable energy. Avista is always evaluating possible community solar options and has a long history of environmentally sustainable practices.

What is the Solar Select program?

The Solar Select program is an opportunity for commercial and industrial electric customers in Washington to acquire solar electricity and the associated Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) with no additional costs.

Is Avista Utilities a sustainable electricity supplier?

Avista Utilities is 125th out of 3529 electricity suppliers in the United States in megawatt hours generated from coal usage. Avista Utilities generates 3,468,109.41 megawatt hours (or 42.71% of their total production) from the use of sustainable fuels in their electricity production facilities.

What are Community Solar and Solar Select?

Avista offers Community Solar and Solar Select as part of their renewable energy projects. Community Solar and Solar Select are options for people who don't have homes suitable for solar panels or those who don't want the burden of owning and maintaining a system.

For each dollar subscribed to our regional option, customers offset greenhouse gas emissions from an average car driving about 175 miles. In 2020, Avista My Clean Energy customers contributions offset more than 26 million kilowatt hours of electric use, with clean, renewable energy - enough to power more than 2,000 homes for one year.

The framework of the utilities' net-metering programs is similar, in that each utility's original program: (1) offers net metering to customers that generate electricity using solar, wind, hydropower, biomass or fuel cells; (2) limits individual system size to 100 kilowatts (kW); (3) limits aggregate net-metered capacity to 0.1% of the utility ...
