

A warning light on the dash will let you know when a fault has been detected with the steering system. What the power steering system warning light means. I have a honda Civic I bought used and had it for about 7 months now. About after a month of driving it I got a messages randomly that said check vsa, hill assist, power steering, and brake system. The brake system would disappear after about 5 seconds, but the VSA hill assist and power steering would remain.

To maintain your Honda Civic"s power steering system efficiently, it is recommended to check the fluid level regularly, ideally every time you open the hood to inspect other fluid levels such as oil or coolant. ... There is no significant difference in price between the Honda power steering fluid and any other fluid brand. The cost is much lower than the fluid required for a Chevy. There is no such thing as "all power steering



fluid." All other manufacturers use a different fluid than Honda (and Acura).

The steering angle sensor feeds the VSA system with the vehicle's wheel angle, turn rate, and other steering wheel information. I accidentally pulled the wrong one now the emissions and vsa check lights are on. My car cuts out at 3000 RPM. I connected the fuse back correctly but it hasn't fixed the problem.
