What is a pumped storage hydropower facility?

What is pumped storage hydropower (PSH)?

Pumped storage hydropower (PSH) is a type of hydroelectric energy storage. It is a configuration of two water reservoirs at different elevations that can generate power as water moves down from one to the other (discharge), passing through a turbine. The system also requires power as it pumps water back into the upper reservoir (recharge).

How does a pumped hydroelectricity storage system work?

In pumped hydroelectricity storage systems, the turbine can become a pump: instead of the generator producing electricity, electricity can be supplied to the generator which causes the generator and turbine to spin in the reverse direction and pump water from a lower to an upper reservoir.

How does a hydro storage system work?

The system utilizes a photovoltaic panel as the main energy source and a battery pack as the energy storage device to smooth the fluctuation of solar power and to mitigate load transients and variations. In addition, a hydro storage system is used for water storage and also for supplying extra electric power via a hydro-turbine generator.
