How do you dispose of batteries?

You must take batteries to an authorized recycling center, a universal waste handler or a household hazardous waste disposal facility. When you know how to dispose of batteries, you can help the environment. Dropoff sites typically accept rechargeable batteries for recycling. For single-use batteries, you can get a mail-order recycling kit.

How do you dispose of a battery in California?

California has strict regulations on battery disposal. Batteries cannot be discarded in the municipal waste stream. They must be taken to an approved household hazardous waste site or battery-recycling center. City and country governments provide drop-off sites.

How do I recycle a battery?

To recycle batteries, you will need to bring them to a battery recycling center or hazardous waste collection in your town. Some retailers also offer battery takeback services. The first step you can take is to check your city's official website for more information on local policies.

Where can I recycle a dead battery?

Call2Recycle is one of the companies that offer mail-in battery recycling kits. The kit comes with a container that you can use to collect dead single-use batteries. When the container gets full, you can mail your alkaline batteries to a recycling center.

Where can I recycle a rechargeable battery?

These batteries must be disposed of at a hazardous waste collection site, recycling facility, or an electronics retailer that recycles batteries. Many electronics retailers, like Radio Shack or Staples, will accept used rechargeable batteries for recycling. Check Earth911.com for participating retailers in your area.

How do you dispose of lead-acid batteries?

For example: in California, all single-use batteries must be recycled or taken to a household hazardous waste disposal facility or similar. Other states like Texas and Virginia only have laws governing the disposal of lead-acid batteries.

Texas law requires businesses that sell these batteries to accept your old one when you purchase a new battery, so your local auto parts retailer or shop should ...

To dispose of the batteries safely, cover the positive terminal of the battery with protective caps or masking tape when grouping used batteries for disposal. This will ensure the battery type is still identifiable at the recycling centre, while also protecting you from danger; do not wrap the entire battery so that it is unrecognisable. ...
