The reason is that the same absolute amount of renewable energy yields a higher renewable energy share, if energy demand growth is diminished because of energy efficiency. As for energy intensity, the annual gain has jumped from an average of 1.3% between 1990 and 2010 to 2.2% for the period 2014-2016, whole falling to 1.7% in 2017 [12].

Seventy countries have transport regulatory incentives or mandates focusing on renewable energy. Twenty-six countries have heating and cooling regulatory policies incentivizing or mandating renewable energy use. The number of countries with renewable energy regulatory policies for power increased significantly from around 90 in 2011 to 156 in 2021.
