

How to disassemble the accumulator liner

Accumulator Disassembly. Slowly loosen and remove the Plug in the Accumulator Cover. Accumulator Disassembly WARNING ... Breaker Disassembly Cylinder Liner. Place the Top Plate on top of the Backhead Mounting Bolts. Thread the Nut onto the Threaded Rod. Breaker Disassembly Cylinder Liner.

Your vehicle's accumulator plays an important role in recycling refrigerant. When the accumulator receives refrigerant from the evaporator, it prevents any liquid refrigerant from entering the A/C compressor, which isn't designed for liquid intake. The accumulator also has a refrigerant reservoir, which is filled with excess refrigerant and a desiccant.

Disassemble each section and remove it from the pool area. Take Apart the Uprights and Wall Bars. Step 1: Remove the screws or bolts that secure the uprights to the top rail and base plate using a socket wrench or screwdriver. Step 2: Carefully disassemble the wall bars by removing any screws or bolts that connect them to the uprights.

If you are not planning to disassemble and clean your Valve Block install a plug in the port immediately to keep dirt out. 2nd hose, the other end of this hard line: Again, the crows foot sneaks right in with a short extension. This end attaches to the small Accumulator junction block. Remove the short hard line entirely and block both ends.

Some craftsmen manage to detect and repair damage to the hull, but such repairs are far from always durable and reliable. Rubber liner or membrane is the weak point of the accumulator. Over time, she wears out. You can replace the membrane with a new element at home, but for this you will have to completely disassemble and reassemble the ...

The average cost for an AC accumulator replacement is \$321. That price breaks down into \$102 for replacement parts and \$220 for labor costs. But you should remember that those are averages and your actual cost will be based on your car and location.

Never attempt to disassemble the accumulator while it is under pressure. Always assume the accumulator is under pressure until it is confirmed that it isn't. Never add unnecessary weight or load on top of the accumulator, never use the accumulator as a structural support and never step on them. The accumulator may become very hot during
