

# How to store energy on panerai s three-eye watch

What makes Panerai a good watch?

The luminous Arabic numerals and hour markers are in the classic Panerai style, easily legible in any environment. The watch has two main complications: a GMT hand and a three-day power reserve indicator at 5 o'clock. It also has a seconds sub-dial with a blue seconds hand, which gives the watch a nice splash of colour.

Does Panerai have a power reserve?

The watch is powered by a special version of Panerai's in-house automatic Caliber P.9010 movement called the P.9010/EL. It has two mainspring barrels (in addition to the four barrels for the light system) providing a full three days of power reserve.

Does Panerai have a battery?

At Panerai, as with most high-end watch brands, the divide between mechanics and electronics is regarded as a sacred line to be treated with utmost caution. "There has never been any battery in any Panerai watch," the brand's CEO, Jean-Marc Pontroué, declares in a Zoom call to explain the watch.

How do you know if a Panerai has a power reserve?

The outline of the small seconds counter at 9 o'clock also glows, as does the pip on the unidirectional bezel. Finally, there's a linear power reserve indicator for the light that also illuminates. It looks like a life meter in a fighting game and tells you at a glance how much light you've got left. A little Panerai ASMR.

Is Panerai a water resistant watch?

It has an impressive water resistance of 500m and its case and bezel are made from Ti-Ceramitech, Panerai's new ceramized titanium material that's 44 percent lighter than stainless steel and ten times harder than ceramic. The material debuted just two months ago at Watches and Wonders.

How does Panerai elux work?

The Elux, in fact, is the first Panerai watch in which the elements outside the movement contain more parts than the movement itself. Initially, the team tried placing LEDs on the dial and using reflectors to direct the light to the hands, but this used too much energy.
