

Jorge Soler officially is a Giant and should be a consistent threat in the middle of the team's lineup in 2024 and beyond. ... Soler is expected to be an everyday force for the Giants, providing much-needed power. "He has always scared me, so hopefully he's on our team scaring the other side," Melvin said on Wednesday. ...

There he is: Jorge Soler is back in the lineup, he's playing right field and he's batting second. Soler has been missing from the lineup since suffering a strained left hamstring back on August 14. However, he did make a pair of pinch-hitting appearances during the Philadelphia series and I'd imagine that he would've played if the DH spot was ...

Soler, 32, is enjoying another strong season offensively with a .240/.330/.419 line and 116 wRC+ over 93 games with the Giants. Over the last month, Soler's been one of the National League's better hitters with a .292/.400/.528 line. Soler was even better on the whole in 2023, posting a 126 wRC+ and 36 homers with the Marlins.

Soler's bat was quite good with Atlanta to the tune of a 135 wRC+ over 182 plate appearances, but it was a nightly disaster defensively in the outfield. With the Braves expected to pick up Marcell Ozuna's option for 2025, the team essentially had two designated hitters with only one spot to play.

The batting average was ugly.

Brian Snitker provided an update on Soler after Thursday's 6-0 loss in San Francisco. Soler is dealing with a mild hamstring strain according to manager Brian Snitker. Soler told MLB's Mark Bowman that he won't play Friday against the Angels, but woke up feeling better Thursday and is hoping he can return to the lineup over the weekend.

Of course, the exciting news is seeing the new lineup, which would hopefully feature 2021 World Series hero Jorge Soler leading off. This appears to be the case. Soler has a .860 OPS in his last two months and for the season is in the top seventeen percent of MLB in walk rate at 11.2 percent of the time.
