What is a power gear leveling system?

The Power Gear Leveling System is a hydraulic system designed to automatically level and stabilize recreational vehicles (RVs) to ensure a comfortable experience for the occupants.

How does an RV leveling system work?

The hydraulic pump powers the leveling system by creating hydraulic pressure to operate the jacks. It is typically powered by the RV's electrical system or a separate battery. The pressure switch monitors the hydraulic pressure in the system and ensures it remains within safe operating limits.

How do I troubleshoot a power gear leveling system?

If the issue persists, consult a professional for further assistance. Troubleshooting a Power Gear leveling system may involve checking for correct calibration and proper mounting, testing for voltage drop, and inspecting electrical components. Additionally, disconnecting wire harnesses and checking hydraulic fluid levels can be helpful.

How do you level up an RV?

Push "ENTER" once while the screen reads "MANUAL MODE". Push the "LEFT" or "RIGHT" arrows to extend either the driver's or passenger's side level-up jacks. (Only one side of the RV will be lifted at a time.) Continue leveling the RV using the "FRONT" and "REAR" buttons.

Why is RV leveling important?

Leveling your RV is incredibly important to your camping experience. But it's not just important for your comfort inside the rig. A level RV is also important for the proper functioning of RV appliances and shower drainage. Manual leveling can be frustrating and time-consuming.

What do led codes mean on a power gear leveling system?
