Solar panels last about 25-30 years, which is similar to the lifetime of a roof. By doing both at the same time, you avoid needing to have your solar panels re-installed after replacing your roof, which can save money in the long-run. Solar panel repair work varies depending on the problem. Sometimes a part needs to be reattached, although this is rare. Usually, your solar provider will give you a replacement instead. If you have a bad crack, your provider will generally replace the glass top without interfering with the wiring beneath.

Solar Panel Efficiency Degradation. Solar panels typically have warranties from 20-25 years, but over time they lose their efficiency which reduces your return-on-investment as time continues. Each year that passes, a solar panel can lose around 0.5-1% efficiency (depending on the age), and older panels can lose the majority of their output capability.

The cost of replacing the glass on a solar panel can vary depending on the size and type of solar panel. In most cases, it is more cost-effective to replace the entire solar panel. If you have a damaged solar panel, it is important to have it repaired or replaced as soon as possible to prevent further damage to your property.

In 2009, the average solar panel had a 5 to 10 year warranty and the inverter had a 3 to 5 year warranty. The increased warranty period has been a result of two main areas: Better technology: The investment of solar manufacturers in research and development has resulted in better technology and manufacturing.

The rate to remove and replace a single panel is around \$100 per hour, and the average cost of the replacement unit is \$150 to \$350 per hour. Costs \$1,800 to \$2,100 to remove an old system and \$17,900 to \$33,700 in solar installation costs to replace the system with new solar panels. How much you spend depends on the number of units that need replacing.

The solar panels and inverter must be on the lists of Clean Energy Council approved modules and inverters.
