To create a more enabling environment, the GoB set up an energy regulator, the Botswana Energy Regulatory Authority (BERA), which began operation in September 2017. This has sparked interest in renewable energy development within the private sector. Botswana also has wind and coalbed methane potential that have not been fully explored.

Oil As of 2019, Botswana had an average monthly fuel consumption of 100 million liters (Gamba 2019). Botswana Oil Limited, the state-owned company charged with the security of fuel supply and management of the Government's strategic fuel storage facilities, reported trading in a combined 87.3 million liters of fuel in the 2017/2018 year (BOL 2019).

In 2021 the share of global electricity produced by intermittent renewable energy sources was estimated at 26%. The International Energy Agency and World Energy Council say a storage capacity in excess of 250 GW will be needed by 2030. The race is on to find alternatives; and progress is being made on refining new



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technologies.
