Hydraulic Leveling System by Power Gear Do not use the Power Gear PowerLevel system as a lift for changing tires or working under the vehicle. Never check for hydraulic fluid leaks using your hands and/or any other body part. Keep people clear of the coach prior to turning the leveling system on and while operating the leveling system.

Stabilizers aren't meant to lift, instead just minimize (not altogether remove) movement inside the trailer. Therefore, they may not carry much weight. Meanwhile, leveling jacks lift and hold the load, so they have a higher weight capacity and frame strength than stabilizers.

First, you will want to make sure your coach is level by manually leveling and using a leveler to verify. Then, you will hold down the "Auto Level" button on your system and then push the power button at the same time. Continue to hold down the "Auto Level" for about five beeps and then let go. Your new auto-level is now set!
