Micro-cracks or issues with components or wiring can normally be fixed by a solar panel technician. However, broken or severely cracked panels may need to be replaced. It's not recommended to attempt to fix a solar panel yourself as this could affect your warranty. Plus, working at height is dangerous without proper training.

Solar energy technicians install and maintain systems that collect solar energy. They prepare the necessary fixtures, often on roofs, install solar panels, and plug them into an electronic system including an inverter to connect the solar energy systems to the electricity lines.
