For example, the cost of solar panels for a 2,500 square foot home would be \$28,750 before incentives and \$20,125 after the 30% tax credit.  $2,500 \times \$11.50 = \$28,750$ . While this method provides a quick-and-dirty estimate for the cost of solar panels, solar systems are sized based on electricity consumption -- not the size of your home.

Here's a closer look at the total costs involved, to help you decide if a solar panel investment makes sense for your home. How Much Do Solar Panels Cost? For most homeowners, the decision to install solar panels is primarily driven by cost. The average cost of solar panels as of Spring 2024 was \$3.40 per watt, excluding financing.

As of January 2022, the average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$2.77 per watt (\$27,700 for a 10-kilowatt system). That means the cost for a 10 kW solar system would be \$20,498 after the federal tax credit discount (not factoring in any additional state rebates or incentives).. Some solar panels are much more efficient at turning available sunlight into the electricity that powers your home. Higher-efficiency panels will cost more, but they can save you thousands in the long run, especially if you live in an area with a good solar buyback program.

**Solar Inverters:** Solar inverters are an essential part of all solar systems and are placed between solar panels and the rest of your home. They convert the direct current (DC) produced by solar panels into alternating current (AC) used by your home. Like solar panels, solar inverters can vary in price based on manufacturer, efficiency and warranty.

The average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$31,558, based on the latest cumulative data from the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, a Department of Energy Office of Science laboratory. Solar panel costs are calculated by the price per watt. The average price per watt in the U.S. is \$3.67 for an 8.6 kW system (rounded up).

Solar panel installation costs a national average of \$16,500 for a 6kW solar panel system for a 1,500 square ft. home. Residential solar panels are usually sized at 3kW to 8kW and can cost anywhere from \$9,255 and \$28,000 in total installation costs.
