The Basics of the Federal Solar Tax Credit. The Solar Investment Tax Credit (ITC) is a federal incentive that allows a significant deduction on the installation costs of solar energy systems. In 2024, this credit stands at 30% of the total cost of solar installation, covering a range of expenses from equipment to labor.

After six years of ownership, the solar system transfers to the nonprofit, which has already essentially received a solar power system with a 15% off coupon.
