

The heat from solar energy can be stored by sensible energy storage materials (i.e., thermal oil) [87] and thermochemical energy storage materials (i.e., $\text{CO}_3\text{O}_4/\text{CoO}$) [88] for heating the inlet air of turbines during the discharging cycle of LAES, while the heat from solar energy was directly utilized for heating air in the work of [89].
