



Tube preamp with solid state power amp

Is a tube preamp better than a solid-state amp?

A good tube preamp along with a solid-state amp can give you the best of both worlds. Of course, your mileage may vary depending upon your preferences. You really have to try it and decide for yourself. My main listening room is set up with a solid-state amp and a tubed preamp however in another room I have all tubed components.

Does tube preamp work with SS amplifiers?

As others have noted, it can and does work very well, but you will have to ascertain that the tube preamp output can properly drive the input impedance of your SS amplifier. Tube preamplifiers typically have higher output impedance than their SS brethren, but that varies greatly from one model to another.

Is a tube power amp a good choice?

Perhaps the best of Tubes and SS. That said there are other benefits to a Tube Power Amp, Beyond their Physical appearance, But the the unique sound of Tubes can for the most part be achieved from the Preamp, or with Hybred Audio Sections in the components. I just got that same preamp and have it paired with a Soundcraftsmen PM860 Mosfet power amp.

Does tube preamp work?

Lots of variables, but many have done it with positive results. As others have noted, it can and does work very well, but you will have to ascertain that the tube preamp output can properly drive the input impedance of your SS amplifier.

Do all tube preamplifiers sound the same?

Cheers! Not all tube preamplifiers sound the same. Some sound very syrupy and (too) lush and others sound crisp and with just a touch of tube warmth. The quality of the sound will ultimately depend on how the (tube) preamp pairs with the upstream and downstream electronics, choice of tubes, cables, the speakers and of course the room.

Nowadays there are solid state amps, and more specifically modeling amps, that can do a pretty awesome job of delivering a tube-like sound, but they can do a whole lot more such as modeling the sound and responses of other specific amp models, modeling effects, amp profiling (essentially, creating a digitalized scan of a real amp), ...

Solid-state amps do essentially the same thing as tube amps. They also have preamp and power amp sections. The preamp section deals with the tone and EQ, with a bit of amplification, while the power amp section boosts the volume. The difference between tube amps and solid-state amps isn't what they do but how they do it.

I've done tube preamp + SS power amp (Lazarus Cascade Basic into Robertson 4010), tube preamp into tube power amp (Aikido LV into various tube amps, some of which are in my signature), and various solid state preamplifiers into tube power amps (Kenwood C2 Basic / Denon PRA-1000 / APT Holman into various tube amps, all of which are in my signature).

Disadvantages of Solid-State Power Amp. Sound quality. A solid-state power amp usually will not provide the same kind of holographic sound that a tube power amp provides. Another way to say this: tubed power amps often sound more layered in the midrange. Or if "layered" is not a helpful term: tubed power amps just have better midrange.

I got decent 5-7 channel sound with good speakers and SS amps, but got great 2 channel sound with the tube preamp and my choice of tube or SS amp. Unless you got a shitload of Google stock to unload, multi channel tube sound will have to be ...

Hybrid amps, on the other hand, combine both tube and solid-state technology. A hybrid amp typically has a tube preamp and a solid-state power amp section. I was using a McIntosh C2600 tube preamp with the power amp section of a solid state McIntosh MA6600. In a way, it was the best of both worlds. A flavor of tubes on the top of solid state bass control and authority. Since then, I have moved into the direction of a fully tube system replacing the MA6600 with the MC275.

And generally, would a full blown tube preamp coupled with a good solid state power amp produce the proverbial "tube sound", or would it be colored by the solid state power at the output? ... Using a tube preamp with a SS amp is a good way to get a taste of some of what tubes can be about, while not going all the way over to the dark side. ...

A tube preamp uses a vacuum tube to increase the power of the phono signal and convert it into what's called line signal. These vacuum tubes have been used for decades and are not reclusive to just phono preamps but also guitar amplifiers and computers. Instead of a vacuum tube, solid-state preamps use an electronic transistor to amplify the sound.

Ultimately, solid-state phono preamps will typically cost less than tube preamps because they're much more simplistic in design and build quality. Unlike tube phono preamps, once you buy a solid-state phono preamp, there's not much else that can be done in the way of improving sound quality from it.

The goal was to keep the circuit simple and the number of amplification stages to a minimum while having enough gain to be driven by most preamplifiers, solid-state or vacuum tube. This suggested using a pentode voltage amplifier stage feeding a cathode follower stage to drive the MOSFETs' rather high gate capacitance.

All outputs are driven by discrete amplifiers. For vacuum tube output, six tubes or valves power the high-level preamplifier section with two 12AT7 tubes and one 12AX7A tube assigned to each the left and right channel. Solid state output is via a discrete balanced op-amp.
