Do large companies charge higher prices for solar energy systems?

This, however, does not generally hold true for solar energy systems. Surprisingly, according to a 2017 report from the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL), larger companies charge higher prices for solar energy systems and installations than smaller, local companies.

Clean Export Guarantee (CEG) Tariff - Get paid for surplus energy . All utility companies are required to pay homeowners for any surplus energy sent back to the grid from their home solar PV system.
