Does Comcast offer backup power?

Comcast does not offer backup power solutions for customer-owned equipment. Xfinity Voice service will not operate during a power failure without a backup power source. An Xfinity Voice Battery Backup case for certain Comcast-provided modems can be purchased from Comcast at any time and is currently priced at \$65, plus tax and shipping.

Does Xfinity Voice have a backup battery?

Does Xfinity have a backup battery?

The Xfinity network device is designed to switch over to cellular internet when the power goes out, and comes with a four-hour backup battery. Comcast's Storm Ready gateway, battery and device. Comcast has a new router designed to stay connected to the internet during storms and power outages.

Does Xfinity cellular backup work?

All you need is Xfinity Internet and a compatible Xfinity Gateway (an internet modem and WiFi router in one). How does the cellular backup work? During a network or power outage, the Xfinity Storm-Ready device automatically switches to a backup 4G LTE cellular network to keep your home online.

Does Xfinity Voice need a backup power source?

If so, you will need a backup power source to make emergency calls using your Xfinity Voice service. In the event of a power outage, Comcast's backup power solution will ensure your phone service remains available for up to 24 hours, provided that the network remains available.

Does Comcast have a battery backup unit?

But it seems odd to have a battery backup unit that doesn't. Was this helpful? If the power outage also affected the commercial power Comcast uses, you will lose internet (in the first case it didn't). The purpose of the battery is to provide phone service, Internet is a bonus.

Comcast uses commercial power, so if there's a substantial power outage, it won't matter what kind of power backup you have, there won't be any service to connect to. On the other hand, depending on the area, and severity of the power outage, they could employ the use of generators to keep service functioning.

I have my own battery backup for my Comcast modem, and when the power goes out or even when I just unplug the battery backup unit, I will lose the internet, the modem just gets a flashing yellow light. Should the modem stay running even without power to the battery backup unit.

Hi @serviceman77 Thank you for visiting our Xfinity Community Forums. The Storm Ready device comes with two Ethernet ports so it is possible to connect via Ethernet. When your modem is down because of a power outage, Storm-Ready WiFi becomes the home WiFi modem using the LTE internet connection and Battery Backup.

I have my generator powering my office including my Xfinity router/modem, PC, etc. With the generator powering everything for my home network I still have no internet service even though Xfinity remote trouble shooting shows no outage. This happens every time my power goes out even though Xfinity tells me everything on their network looks fine.

Voltage regulation in a backup power supply. A sophisticated UPS power supply may offer AVR, or automatic voltage regulation.
